Use of school supplied software

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For the Parent/Caregiver, my responsibilities include:

Reading this *Cyber-Safe Guidelines* carefully and discussing it with my child so we both have a clear understanding of our roles in the school's work to maintain a Cyber-Safe environment.

- encouraging my child to follow the *Cyber-Safe Guidelines*.
- understand that my child is responsible for breaches caused by them allowing any other person to use their e-learning account to access internet and online communication services.
- understand my child is accountable for the misuse of internet and online communication services that may result in behavioural consequences. This may include, but is not limited to, the withdrawal of access to services, suspension, exclusion and possible police involvement.
- ensuring this Agreement is signed by my child, myself and returned to the school.
- contacting the school if there is any aspect of this Agreement I would like to discuss.
- understanding that failure to sign the form means a child cannot use the computer system.
- supporting my child to charge their device nightly.
